1. RATIONALE

- 2.3 To provide a strategy for student security, safety and group management.

3. IMPLEMENTATION

- 3.1 A Uniform Committee, together with the Principal and staff, is to be responsible for implementing the Uniform policy. As part of the PFA The Uniform Committee will meet as required.
- 3.2 The wearing of the uniform as recommended in the 'Welcome to Doncaster Primary School' booklet.

- 3.5 The school uniform embraces our 'Sunsmart Policy'.
- 3.6 Each year the Level 6 students will be able to determine a special Level 6 bomber jacket. This will be available early in the year only.
- 3.7 Jewellery is not permitted, except for studs, sleepers and watches. Tight fitting bracelets and necklets are also not permitted for reasons of safety.
- 3.8 Students will wear the designated school uniform.
 - 3.8.1 When participating in special school groups, students will wear the designated uniform for that group, eg: sports.
