

From the Principal's desk.....

Welcome to a new school year! Special welcome to all our new families, many of whom arrived in the last few days. I'm sure you will feel welcome at our wonderful school and you will make many great friends in our community.

We are looking forward to another successful year with lots of the usual activities and events but there are a few new initiatives we are excited about, so watch out for information in newsletters and on Compass.

I would like to welcome our staff back for another year, you can see the full staff list below. I give a special welcome back to Lisa Foster who was on family leave for the last two years and to Annie Fan who was on leave for 2020. Lisa will be teaching Cultural Studies/Library and Annie Fan will teach Mandarin (LOTE). I would also like to welcome Julienne Hyams who is our Acting Business Manager. At the end of 2020 we bid farewell to Lisa Reuss who was at DPS for many years in an administrative role. In respect of Lisa's wishes her farewell was low key as she didn't want a public goodbye. Lisa has moved back to the country where she grew up and has picked up a position in central Victoria, and we thank her and wish her well.

In 2021 we will continue our Specialist programs including Physical Education with Mr. Spinks, Art with Ms.Lui, LOTE (Mandarin for grades 4/5/6 with Mrs. Fan and Library/Cultural Studies (Prep/1/2/3) with Mrs. Foster.

As well as our Specialist Programs we have a tutoring program designed to support students to reach their potential. Some will be given support to catch up while others will be encouraged to challenge and extend themselves further. Our aim being to support and challenge all students to be the best they can be.

One of our new initiatives this year is the Everest Program. We are very excited about this new program which will challenge our top students beyond their capabilities. More information about the selection process and the program will be provided in coming weeks.

In 2020 we adapted on many levels, including changing bell times to minimise large crowd gathering. Moving forward some of these changes will continue. School bell times are as follows;

Determination Pride Success I hope, like everyone, we can have a more "normal" 2021.

The latest information from DET indicates that precautions and restrictions as per term 4 2020 will continue as follows;

- **Sanitisation of touch points will continue daily.
- **Students and staff must sanitise regularly while in school.
- **Mask wearing and social distancing are to be observed where ever possible.
- **Limits to people in rooms will continue to be observed.
- **Parents are not to gather at school gates if possible and not to enter school the grounds.
- **Assemblies are not permitted at this stage, therefore virtual assemblies will continue lead by our new Captains until further notice.
- **Canteen will be open from Friday February 12th. It may open on other days, which we will inform you about when we can confirm days.
- **Staff must log in electronically on arrival for contact tracing purposes.

Late last year we had a full COVID audit to check on how we were dealing with Dept. of Health expectations as per the operations guidelines. I am pleased, but not surprised that we received an "exemplary" report. I also received a personal letter from our Regional Director congratulating our staff and community for the way in which we dealt with restrictions.

I can say with confidence, this will continue and your children are in very safe hands. I thank you for your ongoing support under the circumstances, we will continue to do our very best to manage the situation while maintaining our focus on education in our wonderful school!

That said, let's hope Victoria and Australia continues to manage this dreaded virus and once the vaccine takes effect, and works, we can get back to the way we were pre Covid.

Unfortunately, we are not able to have open classrooms and our welcome meet the teachers barbecue. If restrictions change in the coming weeks we will endeavour to do this.

Staff started the term on Wednesday January 27th, students in Grades 1-6 started today and our new Preps start their first day at big school tomorrow, Friday. Many staff were in school for the last 7-10 days to prepare for the year ahead which we are all looking forward to.
