1. RATIONALE

Doncaster Primary School strives for excellence in education, purposeful interaction, equality of opportunity, diversity of challenge, and promotes ethical, moral and personal development. The wearing of a school uniform supports this vision.

2. AIMS

- 2.1 To engender a strong sense of purpose, direction, identity and image in the school community.
- 2.2 To create a situation of equal opportunity promoting equity and social justice.
- 2.3 To provide a strategy for student security, safety and group management.

3. IMPLEMENTATION

3.1 A Uniform Committee, together with the Principal and staff, is to be responsible for implementing the Uniform policy. As part of the PFA The Uniform Committee will meet as required.

3.2 The wearing of the uniform as recommended in the 'Welcome to Doncaster Primary School' booklet.

3.5 The school uniform embraces our 'Sunsmart Policy'.

3.6 Each year the Level 6 students will be able to determine a special Level 6 bomber jacket. This will be available early in the year only.

3.7 Jewellery is not permitted, except for studs, sleepers and watches. Tight fitting bracelets and necklets are also not permitted for reasons of safety.

3.8 Students will wear the designated school uniform.

3.8.1 When participating in special school groups, students will wear the designated uniform for that group, eg: sports.
